Meet the *ParkNow* Card

Rediscover downtown with your own *ParkNow* card

Downtown St. Augustine is being rediscovered every day by residents who once thought parking was a problem too big to face. With the introduction of the *ParkNow* card, visiting the historic area has never been easier.

The *ParkNow* card allows the user to park in all city managed parking areas, including on-street spaces, parking lots, and the Historic Downtown Parking Facility at the Visitor Information Center, for just 50 cents an hour.

The *ParkNow* card is the size of a credit card and easy to use. It costs \$2.50 for the initial card and then may be “filled” to increments of \$20, \$50, or \$100. When the card is empty, it can be refilled in just a few minutes by stopping by the city’s Financial Services Center. In fact, you don’t even need to get out of your car if you use the convenient drive-thru window.



The *ParkNow* card is designed for residents of St. Augustine, and frequent visitors to downtown, allowing them to park at a fraction of the cost. One resident recently described the *ParkNow* card as “a passport to visit downtown again.”

Consider the value: A \$20 *ParkNow* card will allow you to park for 40 hours compared to just over 13 hours without a card. In today’s economy, the *ParkNow* card just makes good sense, especially when you consider the value on the card never expires. So even for those who visit downtown only occasionally, why should those occasions be more expensive?

Top 5 *ParkNow* FAQ’s

What is the *ParkNow* card?

A pre-paid card that provides parking at the rate of 50 cents an hour at all city managed parking.

Who can purchase a *ParkNow* card?

Anyone may purchase and use the *ParkNow* card, but it was developed to give residents of St. Augustine and frequent visitors to downtown, discounted parking.

Where can the *ParkNow* card be used?

In all city managed parking areas including on-street spaces, parking lots and the Historic Downtown Parking Facility at the Visitor Information Center.

Where can the *ParkNow* card be purchased?

At the city’s Financial Services Center, 50 Bridge Street, weekdays, 7:30 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. Questions about the *ParkNow* card should be directed to the Parking Division by calling 825-1034.

How is the *ParkNow* card used?

Instructions are included with each *ParkNow* card purchase and machines are located at the Financial Services Center for demonstration.
