RECYCLABLE ITEMS:

- Plastic bottles & jugs—food, beverage, detergent (#1-#7)
- Glass bottles & jars—green brown & clear
- Pill bottles
- Metal cans
- Aluminum cans
- Cereal boxes
- Junk mail
- File folders
- Office papers, copy papers

RECYCLABLE ITEMS (continued):

- Shredded paper (bagged)
- Magazines, catalogs, telephone books, newspapers & inserts (on rainy days, hold till next collection)
- Brown or gray fiber packages—soda cartons, dry food packages, etc.
- Corrugated Cardboard (flattened or cut into 2' x 3' or smaller)
- Brown paper bags (can be used to hold excess recyclables)

DO NOT RECYCLE THE FOLLOWING:

- Light bulbs
- Ceramics
- Broken glass
- Mirrors
- Plastic bags or wraps
- Loose shredded paper
- Aluminum foil
- Plastic toys
- Milk or juice boxes (these are poly-coated & non-recyclable)
