### PUBLIC NOTICE

#### **Road Closure – Eastbound Lane of West King Street**

*Roadway Reconstruction to improve traffic flow, install new traffic signals at Palmer St./Pellicer Lane, upgrade utilities and improve stormwater system*

**St. Augustine, FL – (June 16, 2009)** – Only the eastbound lane of King Street, between Palmer Street/Pellicer Lane and U.S. 1 has open to traffic for the last 13 weeks. This has allowed significant progress to be made on the project, but it has been perceived to make business access within the project area difficult. In response to input from this corridor's business community, the direction of travel ***is going to change effective Monday, June 29, 2009***. In an effort to provide better access to businesses, only westbound traffic will be permitted between U.S. 1 and the Palmer Street/Pellicer Lane intersection.

The eastbound lane of West King Street in St. Augustine will be closed between Palmer Street/Pellicer Lane and U.S. 1 beginning **June 29, 2009** and lasting approximately 6 months. The road closure will facilitate phase 1 of this construction project to rebuild the stormwater drainage system, upgrade water and sewer utilities, improve traffic flow and install a new mast arm traffic signal at the intersection of West King Street and Palmer Street/Pellicer Lane.

During this work phase, detour signs will direct motorists south on Pellicer Lane to South Dixie Highway, east on State Road 207, north on U. S. 1 until they return to West King Street.

These infrastructure improvements are a joint project between St. Johns County, the City of St. Augustine and a grant from the Florida Department of Transportation. S.E. Cline Construction will be performing the work. Barring any material, labor or weather delays, the entire project is scheduled to be completed in early 2010.

***All area businesses remain open.***
