

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, June 22nd and 24th, 2007, mark the Annual Greek Landing Days Celebration in St. Augustine; and

WHEREAS, the Greek Landing Days Celebration memorializes those Greek pioneers who traveled to St. Augustine from New Smyrna on June 26, 1768, seeking prosperity and freedom in the New World; and

WHEREAS, this year's festivities recognize St. Augustine's Greek heritage, with a blessing of its St. Photios Shrine, a reception, lecture and youth rally, and

WHEREAS, the Greek Landing Days Celebration makes a substantial contribution to the cultural life of our community, and helps support the mission of its Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Augustine recognizes the importance of the Greek Landing Days Celebration to the spirit and dignity of the Greek Community and to the historic fabric of our Nation's Oldest City.

*NOW, THEREFORE, the City Commission of the City of St. Augustine does hereby proclaim June 22nd and 24th, 2007, as **GREEK LANDING DAYS** in the City of St. Augustine, and urges all our citizens to attend, participate and share in the rich heritage of St. Augustine's Greek Community.*
