2. Consideration of Resolution 2008-13, certifying the August 26, 2008 primary election results for the City of St. Augustine.

Ron Brown, City Attorney, explained that Resolution 2008-13 certified the results for the office of Mayor/City Commissioner for seat three and the office of City Commissioner for seat two. He stated that the results from the Supervisor of Elections indicated that Joseph L. Boles Jr. received 61.28% of the vote for Mayor/Commissioner seat three and met requirements for election under the Code and Leanna Freeman received 52.23% of the vote for City

Commissioner seat two and qualified for election under the Code.
