Division of Solid Waste and Sanitation Information

For purposes of street sweeping, the city is broken up into different zones such as North City, Lincolnville, West Augustine, etc. Per Rick Stevens, Manager of Solid Waste and Sanitation, this time of the year is heavy leaf season therefore it may take more than one sweep of the sweeper trucks to clear a zone of debris in the streets.
